East Pennine Orienteering Club Summary of Committee Meeting Wednesday 12 September 2018 at 7.30pm Marsh Liberal Club



- 1. Present: Rod Shaw, Emma Harrison, Jackie Page, Neil Croasdell, Jean Lochhead (Chair).
- 2. Apologies: David Morgan and Viv Barraclough.
- 3. Minutes of last meeting approved and proposed a true record Jackie Page, seconded Rod Shaw.
- 4. Matters arising from the last minutes: The minutes were gone through in detail and the committee updated as to progress on the issues mentioned.
- 5. Chairmans Report: Jean reported the success of the last two urban events at the beginning of July both competitor wise and financially. She also reported on the cancellation of Marsden Moor which was unfortunate due to the amount of effort in getting the permissions sorted, but we hope to get permission again for next year in October 2019 as the courses are already planned.
- 6. Treasurers Report: David Morgan had circulated the accounts for the year ended 31 August 2018 that showed a healthy profit due to financially successful events and not much Capital Expenditure. These accounts when audited will be presented to the AGM.
- 7. Future Events: Jean had produced a schedule of events for 2019 with Planners and Organisers where possible. It was proposed that due to the impenetrable and overgrown nature of Cawthorne & Deffer and indeed Haw Park as well, that we should instead put on an Urban (YUL) event on 24 March 2019 and Elland Urban seemed a likely possibility as we have not used the map since July 2015.
- 8. The meeting thought it a sorry state of affairs that more members were not offering to come forward to Organise and Plan events especially as there would be help for anyone not having done it before. It was always the same people who were either Planning or Organising. We are also short of a Secretary.
- 9. POC Report: Crow Nest Park, mapped by Simon Martland and set out by Jackie and Jean was now finished. Shibden Hall has a bit more work to be done. Jean has contacted the relevant person at Hardcastle Crags and that course needs refurbishment and a different system for the supply of maps to augment the system they have now.

- 10. Coaching and Activities: Viv sent an e-mail about Activities she has organised over the summer in Beaumont Park, Greenhead Park, Highburton and Oakwell Hall. There is another activity to be organised in October/November. Viv suggested that we have a stock of multipurpose certificates and would like 15 for the 2017-18 Schools League, which the Committee agreed to. The meeting thought that giving out certificates for Informal activities was not reasonable as prizes should not be that easy come by. It was suggested that some smaller, less formal cards be printed, to give out at informal activities to reflect completion of the course and participation. Jean to liase with Viv as to design, printing and quantity. Simon and Viv are intending to apply for Grants through the Post Code Lottery system and Viv sent a form to be completed and signed by the bank signatories. The meeting decided that this was probably not a problem but wanted more information especially before the bank signatories were involved.
- 11. Welfare Officer: Viv had suggested two paragraphs regarding Codes of Conduct which need to go on to our website this looked complicated and Viv is to do more work on it and come up with the paragraphs which need to go on to our website.
- 12. Amendment to the Constitution: In times that have changed in the 40 years since EPOC was formed Jean suggested that the following clause was required to be added to the Constitution:

"**Power of Committee to Suspend or Expel:** The Management Committee has the power to suspend for a defined period, or terminate the membership of any Member whose conduct renders them unfit to continue their membership. Should the member wish to dispute the committee decision they can appeal in writing putting forward their point of view for the committee to consider. The Committee's decision by a majority vote is final".

This was discussed thoroughly and based on previous experience over the years and experiences with other organisations it was accepted by all that the above clause should be included in the Constitution. This will need to be discussed at the AGM.

It was decided that the position of Vice Chair, whilst in principle very important, was not part of the club's constitutional format so should not be an elected post. Emma was elected originally to support Jean and will continue to do this without the title.

8. Change to Constitution:

In the light of modern times and moral sensibilities, the committee had discussed an addition to the Constitution as follows -

Power of Committee to Suspend or Expel: The Management Committee has the power to suspend for a defined period, or terminate the membership of any Member whose conduct renders them unfit to continue their membership. Should the member wish to dispute the committee decision they can appeal in writing putting forward their point of view for committee consideration. The Committee's decision by a majority vote is final.

The meeting concluded that the above addition should be replaced by wording which would indicate that the club follows the guidelines provided by British Orienteering. As no-one was clear of the exact BO guidelines or wording it was agreed this would be investigated further and discussed at the next meeting.

The proposal to remove the words "including without limitation all clubs and disciplines" from Section 11 (Safeguarding), as they had been unnecessarily included in the club's constitution, was approved.

Since the last AGM we have had 6 events, 4 XC and 3 Urban. They were very successful and well enjoyed by both competitors and helpers. Halifax was a UK Urban League and the previous day although a low entry the courses were popular especially as competitors could do as many courses as they wanted.

We had two different planners this year in Gill Ross and Neil Croasdell.

Marsden was cancelled due to the draught after which it rained and rained. We hope to run the event next October so we can use the courses already planned by Rod.

The SI download team put in a lot of work to make us the first club in YHOA to have SIAC at our events, the rest of Yorkshire may catch up sometime.

Viv has put on some events for youngsters which have been well attended and we were successful in winning our Heat of the CST and Rod has put a good team together for the final in October.

TREASURER'S STATEMENT

David Morgan

This has been a year when event activity has increased significantly and with much less expenditure on major items of equipment. I can therefore report that for the first time in a number of years the club has made an overall surplus.

2 events in particular were very well supported, The Y&H Middle Distance Championships at Storthes Hall and the UKUL event at Halifax. An addition to our programme was the urban event at Brighouse. Entry here was disappointing as it clashed with a number of other events that were not originally on the BOF Fixtures list.

The increase in membership fees that we introduced at the last AGM made a substantial impact on finances without any particular effect on overall membership numbers. Membership fees now cover the cost of BOF and YHOA affiliation, committee room hire and make a contribution to general running costs. It should be noted that for 2018/19 and onwards there will be increased costs relating to management of the club's website. This will be in the order of £240 per year. We again subsidised the entry fees for the CompassSport Trophy heat and as one of the successful clubs will do so again for the final. The costs for this will appear in next year's accounts.

Again, I would however like to congratulate all organisers for their real efforts to minimise costs at events.

COMPASS SPORT TROPHY

I've had an interesting email discussion with Nick Barrable, editor of Compass Sport. Here is a precis of my initial thoughts:

Dear Nick,

"With another Compass Sport Cup/Trophy approaching I wonder whether you would consider for next year's competition the 229 orienteers who are excluded from competing in any meaningful way. There are 66 M80+ and 163 W70+ (according to ranking list) who cannot really compete against orienteers 10 years younger with the possible exception of Carol McNeil and Roger Maher. There is a spare course which isn't used at present "very short green" and as the organisers charge national event prices this could easily be provided."

It transpired that this issue was already under review and I have since received the following email and would be grateful for any feedback you wish to give. Feedback needs to be given to me to send ONE collective reply from EPOC.

Compass Sport Cup: Consultation Veteran Short Green Course

Dear All,

We are consulting about making a change to the Veteran Short Green course for the Compass Sport Cup from **2019** onwards based on feedback on the incompatibility of the participants on this course and the increasing trend in the number of participants, up from 13% of all entrants in 2013 to 16% in 2016.

We are not considering any other changes. Orienteering clubs have and have always had different and changing membership demographics, but the current set of courses allow clubs to put out a team based on their strengths, together with some strategic placement of runners and still be competitive on courses, particularly in the eliminator rounds.

This proposal splits the Veteran Short Green course for scoring purposes and fits together the age categories with as near a fit as practical, based on the running speed ratios in the BOF Rules/Guidelines.

Proposal

Veteran Short Green would become two small courses, scoring 100, 98, 96, 94, 92, in the same way as courses 8A/8B and 9A/9B.

Max four scorers on in the Cup competition Max two scorers on in the Trophy competition

Veteran Short Green Course 7A: W60/M70/M75 Running speeds: M70 – 0.57, W60 – 0.53, M75 – 0.5

Veteran Short Green Course 7B: W65+/M80+ Running speeds: W65 - 0.48, W70 - 0.42, M80 - 0.41, W75 - 0.35, M85 - 0.32, W80 - 0.28

So, your thoughts please:

This will be a good course, Tony is one of the best controllers in UK and has vast experience at all levels.


