Monday Night Runs - An Obituary

It is with sadness that I have to report the passing of Monday night EPOC runs.

A young Anthony Greenwood started these well over 30 years ago. Apparently there was some debate over which night and at what time they should take place. Tuesday was seen as a good choice as this would give a day of recovery. However EPOC folklore suggests that many members had a knitting class on a Tuesday night, so Monday was chosen as a better alternative as the runs could act as a loosener from the previous days exertions.

A winter location was chosen, which was Albert Promenade, along with a time of 19:00 hours, late enough that some could eat before, early enough that others could eat on their return home. Summer was to feature a wide range of locations in the Halifax locale, with the occasional "awayday!"

At its peak the Monday run attracted well over 30 runners, the record being somewhere in the region of 40! There were three to four groups, the piece de resistance being that everyone would run roughly the same loop through town or country. The sheer cleverness of Anthony's planning, was that the faster runners got a longer run, but being sent on long loops, with instruction of where the next meeting point would be. The slower runners would be sent on a shorter route to the same meeting point. When these loops were planned to perfection all the groups would meet up at the same time. This genius plan meant that runners could change loops and do a long loop, then a medium route, and if they wanted go to a slow one for a loop. Occasionally in foul weather we would head to the no extinct multi-storey car park near Bull Green for some "interval games" which involved laps, stairs, and ramps.

Different members took the lead each week, with Anthony being the driving force in winter. We got taken to places in Halifax that one would not normally go to, and some you wouldn't want to revisit. After many years Anthony retired from the Monday runs, so that left me and Mike Thorpe to take over. Membership of EPOC was by now in steady decline, but we persevered, and still had a decent turn out. We picked up friends of EPOC, and indeed friends of friends. We kept the format the same and it really worked.

There were some memorable incidents, but usually nothing really happened on these runs, other than running. However one did get adept at not getting too far ahead of Anthony, as he would often change direction, when you were least expecting it, as well as knowing that this was not "the last hill…"

One of the two of my lasting memories however was when Ivor Noot was leading a run through Trimmingham. We got to a crossroads, and Ivor told the medium and slow group to head up to Warley, the fast group, and he named names I recall, "you are coming with me up here..." So we all dutifully ran up the steepest hill in Trimmingham, eyeballs out, trying to keep up with whoever was at the front. Ivor brought up the rear, and half way up shouted, "Turn around, we're going back down and on to Warley!" There was a huge groan from the group as we had to lose all the height we had gained only to gain it back on another road!

The other memorable occasion was on Midgley Moor, when EPOC hanger on Steve was waxing lyrical about the benefits of off road running, and how the uneven terrain had really strengthened his ankles, so meant he got less football injuries. No sooner had he finished his praise but he slipped and twisted that strengthened ankle. Not sure we ever saw him again!

Over the last ten years, numbers got smaller and smaller, until only myself, Dave Wakeford and Dick Spendlove were regularly running. Dick would week in week out run both me and Dave into the ground. Then when Dick was off on his Jollies, just Dave and I would venture out. Dave slowly realising that perhaps he might be better suited to running with Sowerby Snails. So that just left me, and Dick when he was at home. I still tried to get out when I could, but illness made this really difficult.

Part time working however meant that I did not work on Mondays or Fridays, so I could walk, run or ride during the day.

So that is why the Monday night runs are no more.

However Dick and I still meet up to run on Mondays, during the day, often from the Secret Café in Luddendenfoot, or from Craggies up Cragg Vale. So if any EPOC members find themselves at a loose end and want a gentle hour's run (5 or so miles) usually from a café, then contact me, and we can get running socially again. Hangers on most welcome. Long live the Mon DAY runs.

La Sportiva Lake District Mountain Trial 2019

Classic mountain navigation event over challenging terrain in the Lake District. Interval starts with course disclosure beyond start line - ie. as in orienteering. The Trial is excellent preparation for the OMM.

Entries are now open for this year's trial to be held on September 15th, starting and finishing at Stool End Farm, Great Langdale. Entries close on 26th August.

Classic Trial: around 18 miles and 7500ft climb (29 km and 2300m). Estimated winning time = 4.5hrs. Minimum age for entry: 18yrs

Medium Trial: around 13 miles and 5000ft climb (21 km and 1500m). Estimated winning time = 3.5hrs. Minimum age for entry: 18yrs

Short Trial: around 9 miles and 3500ft climb (15 km and 1100m). Estimated winning time = 3hrs. Minimum age for entry for single runners: 18yrs.

The distances shown above are as the crow flies. Actual distances covered may be up to 50% further.

There is a Pairs category in the Short Trial. This presents a good opportunity to hone navigational skills with a partner. Over 14's may compete as part of a pair if the other runner is their parent or legal guardian.
