

Judy Woods Lockdown event.

Parking. Approach Judy Woods from the A58 into Rookes Lane (HX3 8PU) and into the village of Norwood Green. At the end of Rookes Lane turn right onto Station Road. Park on Station Road on the left hand side. Even if you are coming from Bradford do NOT enter Station Road from the east.

Map. The event will use EPOC's orienteering map. Yellow shows open land, white is woodland and green is thicker woodland, best avoided. Paths and tracks are shown as black dashed lines. The scale is 1:7,500

The map is available on MapRunF. The course and Google Earth will appear on your mobile phones but please ensure that you print off a copy of the map before starting. Please do not plan your routes in advance.

Terrain. Runnable deciduous woodland with many tracks and paths some of which are rather vague on the ground. New paths and tracks have also appeared, usually created by mountain bikes. This long and narrow area follows a substantial stream from north to south often with very steep banks. It is a very popular area for dog walkers and family outings. Please behave with consideration for other users of the woods.

Courses. There are three courses: short (2.0 km) medium (3.6 km) and long (4.9 km). Control sites are path junctions, depressions, clearings and crossing points. They can be a bit slow to register and sometimes are a bit further along the path than you would expect from the map. If you do not get a ping on your phone but are confident you are in the right place just keep going. Corrections can be made at the end.

Safety Considerations. There are no road crossings but some courses traverse very steep banks which can be slippery when wet. Please observe social distancing and respect other members of the public at all times.
