Flanshaw (Wakefield) Details

The start and finish are by Grasmere Road playing fields the start being at the junction of Grasmere Road and Eskdale Road. There is a small car park by the playground which is on the right hand side soon after turning into Grasmere Road from Batley Road. This generally seems to be almost empty unless there are any football matches or training. If the car park is full there are plenty of residential streets nearby but please park considerately.

I hope that the routes likely to be used are reasonably mapped. The medium and long courses have some legs on rough open land which may be quite wet and boggy. All courses also go across the playing fields which could also be wet. The map scale is 1:7500.
