

Outwood & Stanley

Details

Outwood and Stanley are two of the most northern areas

of EPOC's territory. Outwood is part of the Rhubarb Triangle whilst Stanley is home to the Stanley Marsh [nature reserve](#) which is a site consisting of varied terrain including a lake. The reserve is situated on the site of a former colliery,

The [Anglican parish church, St. Peter's](#), a large dominant building, was constructed in 1822 at a cost of £12,000 and opened on 6 September 1824. It was demolished in 2014 only the graveyard remains
