<u>Parking</u>: On Norland Road. Park tightly on the right hand (E) side of the road after you pass the pub.

Public Transport: Buses 561/2, C6, E4 on Rochdale Road.

"Billy Goat" Score			A Score with a twist: There will be 30 controls. Different age categories will need to miss out different numbers of controls from the 30 and visit the rest as quickly as they can. Which to miss out is an individual's choice. There will be a family category as well.

Registration, Social Space, Refreshments and Toilets: We will be based at the excellent Spring Rock Pub where we have food, drink and social space available. Please take the chance to eat, drink and chat after your run. The pub are really keen to welcome you and have been very helpful and positive.

<u>Terrain</u>: Open and semi- open moorland with complex quarried areas. Panoramic views. Mixed runnability. Careful choice of path options to be balanced with some slow running through heather between paths.

Start: Open punching starts between 12.30 and 1.30pm. 5mins jog/ 10mins walk from Registration on footpaths.

Finish: Adjacent to Start. Courses close at 3pm
