**Registration, Social Space, Refreshments and Toilets:** We will be based in the Ivy House Pub beer garden or in an upstairs room if the weather is poor. Food, drink, toilets and the social space is available.

**Terrain:** . Open parkland and the rewilded woodland and meadows of the old Duke of Wellington's barracks.

**Map:** 1:5000 scale 5m contours. Surveyed in 2025 by Jonathan Emberton

**Entries:** Through the Racesignup entry page up to the day of the event

**Entry Fees:**

Before 14th July Senior £5.00, Young Adult (21-25) £2.00, Junior £1.50

After 14th July and entry on the day- Senior £6.00, Young Adult (21-25) £3.00, Junior £2

Non British Orienteering members senior supplement £2

**Entry on the Day:** Available subject to map availability

**Start:** Open punching starts between 6 and 7pm. 5 mins walk from Ivy House event base

**Finish:** Adjacent to Start. Courses close at 2pm

**Safety:** A comprehensive risk assessment will be carried out by the organiser. The risks associated with competing in an outdoor environment are significant and need to be taken seriously by all competitors who take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety.
