Parking: Hollins Mill Lane, Sowerby Bridge. Park on the right hand side please. This is now a no through road.

Event Base: Puzzle Hall Inn, Hollins Mill Lane.

Registration and Finish on the outdoor terrace. Excellent pub for post event socialising. Toilets. Why not stay and enjoy their Folk and Roots evening from 8pm

Public Transport: Frequent trains from the east and west on the Calder Valley Line. 5 mins walk from station. Many buses to Sowerby Bridge Wharf Street.

Courses:

There will be qualified coaches from both clubs happy to give advice and demonstrate techniques to try out on the courses.

Course	Distance (km)	Climb (m)	What to expect
GREEN	6.0 (2.5+3.5)	100	The GREEN will use 2 maps to give a combination of a Park and Woodland course in Dixon Scar and Urban
SHORTER GREEN	2.5 or 3.5	50 or 50	StreetO course in Sowerby Bridge. There will be plenty of good running and a technical challenge suitable for developing and experienced navigators alike. If you want a SHORTER GREEN, you could choose to do either the Park/Woodland course or Urban StreetO course.
			Just decide and let us know when you register on the night after you've seen the maps and had a chat with us
Yellow	1.8		Easy course suitable for beginner navigators and juniors

Terrain: Dixon Scar has a great mix of parkland, paths, sports pitches, runnable woodland, steep slopes, rock features and a large cemetery. Sowerby Bridge is an urban mix of victorian streets, canal basins and small parks.

Maps: 1:4000 scale 5m contours. Dixon Scar Surveyed in 2024 by Jonathan Emberton, Sowerby Bridge in 2021 by Richard Payne

Start: Open punching starts 400m from the Event Base between 6pm and 7pm

Finish: At the Event Base. Courses close at 8pm

Entries: Through the Racesignup entry page up to the day of the event
